SECTION XV. 711. INVESTIGATIONS

711.1. The purpose of this section is to provide for the investigation of the following:

1. The cause and extent of any damage to property.
2. The cause and extent of any injury to persons.
3. The cause and extent of any loss of property.
4. The cause and extent of any loss of income.
5. The cause and extent of any loss of reputation.
6. The cause and extent of any loss of honor.
7. The cause and extent of any loss of respect.
8. The cause and extent of any loss of dignity.
9. The cause and extent of any loss of honor, respect, or dignity.
10. The cause and extent of any loss of honor, respect, or dignity.

711.2. The investigation shall be conducted by a person who is qualified to conduct such an investigation.

711.3. The investigation shall be conducted in a fair and impartial manner.

711.4. The investigation shall be conducted in a timely manner.

711.5. The investigation shall be conducted in a confidential manner.

711.6. The investigation shall be conducted in a professional manner.

711.7. The investigation shall be conducted in a thorough manner.

711.8. The investigation shall be conducted in a complete manner.

711.9. The investigation shall be conducted in a detailed manner.

711.10. The investigation shall be conducted in a comprehensive manner.
